More than 1,000 spectators attended this Show at the Vernon Recreation Centre. The first show was open to all quilters in the Okanagan. Salmon Arm quilter Doris Murray captured Viewers' Choice. A wallhanging entitled Jade Bay placed second; third place was awarded to Erla Horne of Salmon Arm for a quilt entitled String of Pearls.

In January 1993 another raffle entitled "Houses" was won by Patricia Arsenueau of Calgary, who happens to be the daughter of Guild member June Copeland. Donations of \$325 each to O'Keefe Ranch and the Upper Room Mission resulted from this raffle.

Demonstrations this year included Louise Klassen, Doreen Wilshire, Lorene Hill, Zona Schick, Ranita Brown.

Nineteen preemie quilts were sent to the Children's Hospital in Vancouver. The world of three-dimensional flowers was introduced to the members by Pat Clifton in a workshop attended by many members.
