



Stone Sheep won the Award of Excellence, Workmanship by a First Time Exhibitor, at Quilt Canada in Vancouver in June.


It will now participate in the Best of Canada Quilts exhibit at The New England Quilt Museum in Lowell, Massachusetts from January to April, 2023.


