








Silver Star Quilt Puzzle

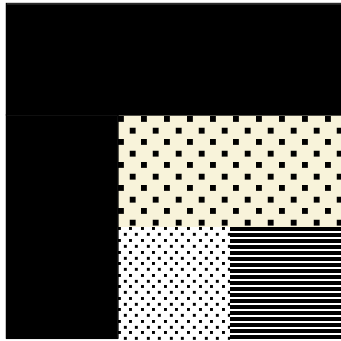
Compliments of Quilt Sitters Circle

This pattern includes sewing several different traditional 6" blocks using quick cutting and piecing techniques to make an original quilt top measuring 36" square, plus borders. After sewing all the blocks, you will place them in several different layouts to form a one-of-a-kind design. This is a FUN, EASY, and innovative method for creating an original quilt top.

The design requires ONE focus print (also for the border), FOUR complementary colours (1 dark, 2 mediums, 1 light) to complement the focus fabric, and TWO neutrals (fairly even in value).

Fabric:

Neutral #1	0.7 m	
Neutral #2	0.9 m	
Focus	1.15 m	
Light	0.7 m	
Medium #1	0.15 m	
Medium #2	0.15 m	
Dark	0.7 m	

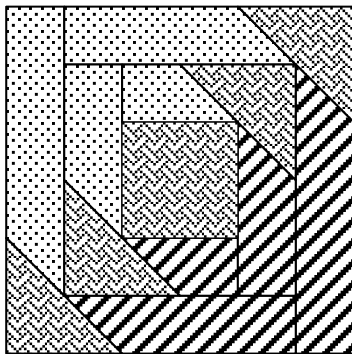


BLOCK 1

Make 4

6 inches finished

Use 2½ inch cut strips



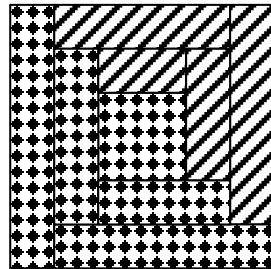
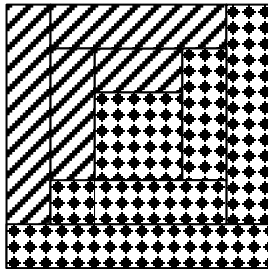
BLOCK 2

Make 8

6 inches finished

Use 1½ cut strips

Use 2½ inch cut squares for centre and connector corners



BLOCK 3

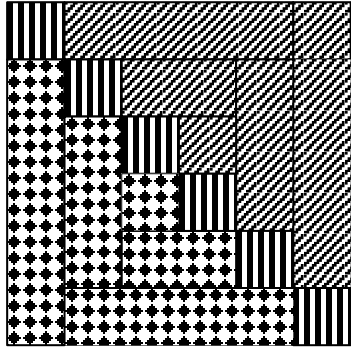
Make 4 of each

6 inches finished

Remember these are mirror image

Use 2½ inch cut centre

Use 1½ inch cut strips

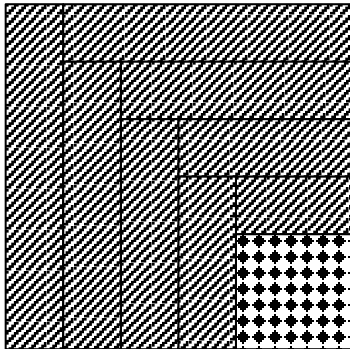


BLOCK 4

Make 4 6 inches finished

Use 1½ inch cut strips and 1½ inch squares

Hint: This one starts with a four patch in the centre. For the rounds, sew a square to one end of your neutral strip, then attach the block to it. Trim the opposite end of the strip.

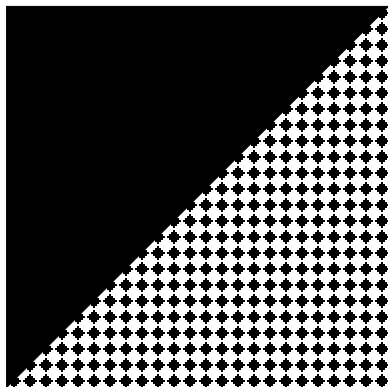


BLOCK 5

Make 4 6 inches finished

Use 1½ inch cut strips

Use 2½ inch cut centre



BLOCK 6

Make 8 6 inches finished

Use your preferred method for HST

Or

Use 6 /12 inch strip if using an Easy Angle ruler

Or

Use 7 inch cut squares for grid system
